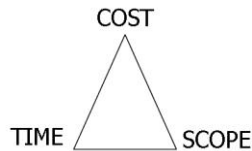

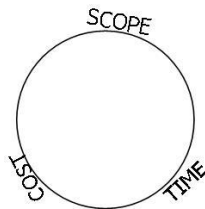
In software circles, the iron triangle references the interrelated consideration in the development process for scope, time, and cost.
